Helmet Mount

Instructions, Please Read!

The ChaseCam Helmet Mount provides an easy way to secure your ChaseCam bullet camera to many surfaces, including a racing helmet or to the ChaseCam Shoulder Harness. The ChaseCam Helmet Mount also can be mounted to a bike helmet using zip ties, and it can be mounted using the two holes provided for a direct mounting solution. Note, we do not recommend putting any holes into a helmet.

Mounting to a racing helmet

1. Remove the installed nut from the mount.
2. Install the bullet camera against the foam cushion and insert the mounting hardware. Thread into the rear of the bullet camera. There should be a lock washer under the screw head to retain the screw. You may wish to not fully tighten the screw until the camera has been aimed.
3. Position the camera on the helmet in the location you wish to use. You may wish to experiment with using the top of the helmet and the side of the helmet. We recommend using some painter's tape to position the camera while viewing the video output. This will enable a perfect placement. Using the tape or an erasable marker, note the location of the mount on the helmet.
4. Peel off the mating Velcro and remove the adhesive backing tape.
5. Position the Velcro on the helmet. Press firmly.
6. Position the camera and mount onto the Velcro and check aim.
7. You can move the camera slightly from the rear, and rotate it also.
8. Tighten the rear fasteners.
9. Using the supplied small zip tie, secure the front of the camera to the tab on the front of the mount.
10. We suggest using some of the painter's tape to "dress" the wire from the bullet cam along the helmet.
